Day 2: Saturday April 26

Visit Isola del Deserto and Burano. Lunch on Burano at own cost. Visit to nearby Torcello, the island with ancient mosaics before return to Madonna dell'Orto or San Marco. Dinner provided

Day visit with ferry crossing to Isola Maggiore where Francis spent Lent 1211, returning by ferry mid-afternoon.

Continue by coach to Assisi and transfer to St Anthony's Guesthouse, run by the Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement.

Day 8: Friday May 2 - Day 14 Thursday May 8

Visits within Assisi will be arranged by Jenny and John. These will include a guided visit to the Basilica of San Francesco, and visits to San Damiano, the Basilica of Santa Chiara, the Carceri Sanctuary on Mt Subasio, Rivotorto, Santa Maria degli Angeli and other important sites in Assisi. Pilgrims will have many options for reflective time and service attendance, particularly Vespers at San Damiano and Santa Chiara, and Sunday Eucharist at St Leonard's Anglican Chaplaincy. There may also be a half day Franciscan retreat with Archbishop David. Own dinner arrangements each night.

Dinner and overnight Hotel Serena Rieti

Day 17: Sunday May 11

Morning visit to Fonte Colombo sanctuary where Francis was cared for in his illness. Lunch in Rieti township at own cost. Afternoon visit to Greccio sanctuary where Francis initiated the first living nativity.

Dinner and o'night Hotel Serena Rieti

Day 18: Monday May 12

Check out of Hotel Serena.

Travel by coach to Monasterio San Benedetto Subiaco where St Benedict lived for three years in a cave.

Lunch in Subiaco township.

Travel by coach to St John Lateran in Rome where Francis visited the Pope, and the seat of the Bishop of Rome.

Travel by coach to Domus Internationalis Paulus VI

Dinner and o'night at Domus

Day 19: Tuesday May 13

Morning orientation walk in old Rome, possibly finishing with attendance at lunchtime Eucharist at the Anglican Centre in Rome.

Free afternoon.

Attend Papal audience in the Vatican Square.

Afternoon opportunity for pilgrims to visit the Vatican Museums, St Peter's Basilica and Dome.
